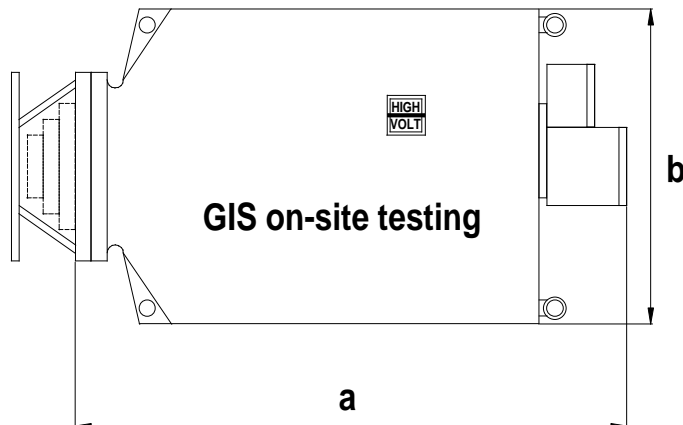
SF₆-Insulated Reactors

Description:

SF₆-Insulated Reactors have been developed for the use in Resonant Test Systems with variable frequency for GIS on-site testing and are directly flanged to the GIS. They are also suited to increase the test power of conventional low-power SF₆-insulated test transformers essentially by a high-voltage-side parallel compensation of the capacitive reactive power. Furthermore they can be equipped

with a SF₆-to-air bushing for testing air-insulated components or GIS via air bushings.

The design of these resonant reactors is similar to that of instrument transformers with a combined SF₆-foil-insulation and a disk bushing. A capacitive divider for the voltage measurement is integrated in the pressure vessel.
